VIOLATION NOTICE

On April 11, 2018, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Georgia Pacific Chemicals, LLC located at 4113 East 4 Mile Road, Grayling, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Georgia Pacific Chemicals, LLC compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the Air Pollution Control Rules; and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 363-89C.

The records provided demonstrate that actual emissions of fugitive formaldehyde from FGFORMALDEHYDE and FGRESIN are 0.142 pounds per hour, which exceeds the limit of 0.006 pounds per hour listed in conditions of PTI number 363-89C.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by July 11, 2018 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

Please submit the written response to the DEQ, AQD, Cadillac District Office, at 120 West Chapin Street, Cadillac, Michigan 49601 and submit a copy to Ms. Jenine Camilleri, Enforcement Unit Supervisor at the DEQ, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7760.

If Georgia Pacific Chemicals, LLC believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
