On Aug. 6, I conducted an annual inspection at Eura Craft Interiors, Inc., located on 6611 Diplomat, Sterling Heights. There is an active permit (#686-87) for the site. The permit was issued to P.C. Gage & Tooling, Inc. I arrived at the location around 1:55 PM. I introduced myself to Ms. Maria Vitale from Eura & explained the purpose of the inspection. Afterwards she took me to see the process.

**Inspection:**

The company is in the business of building cabinets. The cabinetry is mainly sold to builders & general contractors. The operation involves wood working & small coating process. All the wood working processes are exhausted at the in-plant environment; therefore, they are exempted from the permit to install requirements according to Rule 285 (I) (vi).

**Permit # 686-87**

This permit covers a paint spray booth. During the inspection, they did not operate the coating process. I observed some overspray inside the booths. Ms. Vitale told me that she was not aware of the permit. According to the company, they changed the filters of the booth every 3 months. Paints were stored in closed containers inside a fire proofed cabinet. I didn't see any spills in the storage area. Spray guns are cleaned by purging lacquer thinner through. Spent solvents were stored in a closed container which will be sent to Crystal Clean. HVLP gun is used in the booth. On 8/11/2018, the company submitted the paint usage data. The record shows that the company has used less than 200 gallons of coating per month since July 2014. The operation is exempted from PTI requirements according to Rule 287(c). As a result, the company will void the permit #686-87.

In conclusion, the coating operation is exempted from permit requirement per Rule 287 (c); the company appeared to operate in compliance with the air quality regulations.
