Comfort Research is in receipt of the above referenced violation notice (VN). In response, Corrective Action Plan (CAP) 2017-001 was created to mitigate the fallout observed on November 17, 2016.

CAP 2017-001 states the root causes are as follows:

- Current bead process results in a large number of small pieces mixed with the larger beads.
- Filters in Hirsch steam stack are not efficiently catching and filtering out the small pieces after the expansion process.
- PM's are not being performed on Hirsch.

The following permanent corrective actions are being evaluated and verified:

- Get a larger shipments of low dust beads to confirm density studies.
- Get data from RAPAC on reduction of dust with low dust beads.
- Evaluate other filter sizes for fluidized dryer bed filters.
- Evaluate cyclone in steam stack to catch dust.
- Investigate Hirsch PM's.

Once permanent corrective actions are implemented and validated, we will maintain PM processes to prevent recurrence of the issue.
