In response to the violation from the June 1, 2017 compliance inspection for the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451) and the associated Air Pollution Control Rules and our Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) No. MI-ROP-N1966-2015, we have implemented the following countermeasures.

Violation: The Company failed to provide documentation that demonstrates that they are in compliance with all of the requirements of the BOILER MACT.

Response: MACI has contacted a certified EPA Energy Assessment company to complete the required Energy Assessment. An Initial Notification Report was submitted in March 2014. Once the energy assessment is completed, MACI will notify the MDEQ. Since all MACI Boilers are gas fired boilers, they are exempt from reporting.
