
Dear Dr. Wendling:

This letter follows up on FCA's December 20 meeting with AQD, during which the parties discussed FCA's response to AQD's October 20, 2021 Violation Notice ("VN"). As you know, the VN alleged a violation of EU-PRIMER, Special Condition IV.1 of Permit to Install No 14-19a for the failure to duct emissions from EUPRIMER ambient flash zone to the regenerative thermal oxidizer control ("RTO").

As discussed yesterday, FCA completed the ducting to connect the unabated ambient flash zone to the existing concentrator and RTO on December 19. As a result, the RTO now controls the ambient flash zone emissions as indicated in FCA's air permit.
