Thank you for the visit on January 17<sup>th</sup>. I would like to take the actions necessary to apply for an accurate permit for operations that we would perform if we are able to get back up in running by this spring or summer. I feel that if we ever get into a larger scale production similar to the time we manufactured the military hoods during 2015 and 2016 we would need to increase the gel coat usage to around 2 drums per week. All resin applications are close molded for production and prototyping.

Our original permit from when my familiar had the car body business was all open molded and hand lay wet out and low volume. Then it was sold to the Legend motors group. Once they defaulted on their payment terms to our family they were evicted off the property in 2008.

As for now there is no chance of reoccurrence due to the fact we are shut down and have no employees besides myself and a part time book keeper.


In the mean as I continue to ramp business back up I would like to know the appropriate steps to void our current permit and apply for a more accurate one. Thank you.
