On 07/06/2018, I conducted an unannounced target inspection at American Aggregates of Michigan located at 2101 Inwood Road, Romeo, Michigan. During the pre-inspection office file review, I found out that this facility has an existing permit to install (PTI), PTI No. 572-91, for a sand and gravel processing plant.

During site inspection, I observed that the facility was fenced and the gate was padlocked. There was a big "American Aggregates Romeo Plant" sign near the entrance. I observed signs posted by the gate: "Private Property No Tresspassing" and "PROPERTY CONTACT EDW C. LEVY SECURITY (313)429-2386". I tried to peak by the gate and barely observed a small lake inside the property but no equipment in sight and no activity ongoing inside the property. The property appeared to be bounded by Mt. Vernon Road to the east, Inwood Road to the south and Dequindre Road to the west. The entrance gate is along Inwood Road. I drove west to the end of the property line (Dequindre Road) and north along Dequindre Road until I came across residential houses about quarter of a mile north from Inwood Road. I could observe from the fence line along Dequindre Road that there was no activity inside the property and no equipment visible from the roadway.

As a result of my inspection and investigation, I am going to recommend to AQD Permit Section to void PTI No. 572-91 and note that this facility is now shutdown. I will try to contact EDW C. LEVY Company to inform the company of my findings and obtain additional information on the status of property ownership and the equipment that was removed from the facility.
