

VIOLATION NOTICE

On August 9, 2016, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of State Crushing, Inc. located at 2260 Auburn Road, Auburn Hills, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine State Crushing, Inc.'s compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the Air Pollution Control Rules; and to investigate a recent complaint which we received on August 8, 2016 regarding fugitive dust/fallout attributed to State Crushing, Inc.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

EUPROCESS - Concrete crushing operations	PTI No. 8-16, SC.VI.3 and 5 (R 336.1201(3)) performance and record keeping requirements for daily visible emission observations	AQD staff requested the records for daily visible emissions observations and Mr. Orozco did not have them available. State Crushing, Inc. has not been keeping records of the daily visible emissions observations. In addition State Crushing Inc. was unable to demonstrate that the facility has been performing daily visible emission observations.

During this inspection, State Crushing, Inc. was unable to produce visible emission observation records. This is a violation of the recordkeeping requirement specified in Special Condition VI.5 under EUPROCESS of PTI number 8-16. The conditions of PTI number 8-16 require State Crushing, Inc. to record daily visible emissions observations.

State Crushing Inc. was also unable to demonstrate that the visible emission observations have been performed. This is a violation of Special Condition VI.3 under EUPROCESS of PTI number 8-16.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by September 16, 2016 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of these violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

State Crushing, Inc. may use the attached "Department of Environmental Quality-Air Quality Division Method 9-Visible Emissions Form" to tabulate the daily visible emissions readings. Please make sure all the information requested in PTI No. 8-16 SC VI.5 is included in the observation form.

If State Crushing, Inc. believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.

Thank you for your attention to resolving the violations cited above and for the cooperation that was extended to me during my inspection of State Crushing, Inc.
