VIOLATION NOTICE

On Feburary 11, 2016, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Precision Concepts, Inc. located at 109 East Sanilac Road, Caro, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Precision Concepts, Inc.'s compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 117-93A.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

FGFIBERGLASS which consist of fiberglass production, resin applicators, gelcoat applicatiors, and cleanup activities	Special Condition 2.10: Shall complete all required emission calculations	Permitee was not maintaining emission calculation records for any of the equipment listed in the permit
FGFIBERGLASS which consist of fiberglass production, resin applicators, gelcoat applicatiors, and cleanup activities	Special Condition 2.13 a) - f): Shall maintain monthly records of the following: identity and amount of each material used, amount of clean up solvent reclaimed, the VOC content of material, VOC/Acetone emissions (with annual rates), emission factors used	Permitee was not maintaining records.

During this inspection, Precision Concepts, Inc. was unable to produce emission records. This is a violation of (the recordkeeping and emission limitations) specified in Special Condition number 2.10 and 2.13 of PTI number 117-93A. The conditions of PTI number 117-93A require maintenance of records which shall be made available for review upon request by the AQD staff.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by March, 8, 2016 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If Precision Concepts, Inc. believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.

Thank you for your attention to resolving the violations cited above and for the cooperation that was extended to me during my inspection of Precision Concepts, Inc..
