**VIOLATION NOTICE**

On May 10, 2017 and June 12, 2017, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted inspections of Chemico Systems, Inc. located at 50725 Richard West Boulevard, Chesterfield Township, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Chemico Systems' compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the Air Pollution Control Rules; the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 127-16; and to investigate recent complaints which we received on April 24, 2017 and May 15, 2017, regarding foul odors attributed to Chemico Systems' operations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

EUOVEN4	PTI 127-16, Special Condition IV.1.	Records indicate the afterburner temperature for EUOVEN4 was less than 1400 degrees Fahrenheit, on multiple occasions, when EUOVEN4 was operating.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by **August 11, 2017** (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
