On Tuesday, April 17, 2018, Caryn Owens and Tammie Puite of the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) – Air Quality Division (AQD) conducted a scheduled field inspection of Alken Zeigler (N5947) located at 406 West Park Drive in Kalkaska, Kalkaska County, Michigan. The facility incorporated three buildings located in the Village of Kalkaska Industrial Park, on the south side of Park Drive (containing existing addresses of 210 West Park Drive, 406 South Park Drive, and 606 South Park Drive). The purpose of this inspection was to determine whether a permit to install is necessary, since the facility was operating under exemption R 336.1279, which has been rescinded.

Source Description

Upon arrival at the facility, the site was covered in snow, and two of the three buildings were for sale, and were not plowed nor have tracks leading to them. The center building was plowed and was an Auto Value in the northern portion of the building, and Doug's Garage & Off-Road Center in the southern portion of the building. According to the information on file, Alken Zeigler was a tool and die, and machining facility, and the buildings contained numerous stamping machines and parts washers. Buildings #1 and #3 (406 and 606 S. Park Dr. location) contained warm forming machines equipped with smog hog control equipment. The facility claimed to meet exemption R 336.1281 for the parts washers and indicated the stamping machines did not vent to the outside.

Additional Research

Through additional research, AQD obtained information that Alken-Zeigler went out of business in 2012. It appears that Buildings #2 and #3 are currently for sale and appeared vacant during the field inspection and Building #1 was purchased by Doug's Garage in 2016.

Based on the information reviewed, and the field inspection, it appears the tool and die services are no longer in use at this location. No further action is necessary at this time.
