VIOLATION NOTICE

On April 25, 2014, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), received a relocation notice for Aggregate Industries Plant NB-1 (Facility) scheduled to be located at the Reith Riley Plant, Kalamazoo County, Michigan, on April 23, 2014. This relocation notice was late. The Permit to Install (PTI) No. 112-11A, Condition IX.2.b, requires that relocation notices be provided at least seven days prior to the scheduled relocation.

If the Facility believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
