VIOLATION NOTICE

On February 15, 2017, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of PPI Aerospace located at 13514 Groesbeck Highway, Warren, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine PPI Aerospace's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the Air Pollution Control Rules; and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 294-00D, 120-02, and 3-03.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Process Description	Rule/Permit Condition Violated	Comments
EUBLINE	PTI 294-00D, Special Condition 3.1	Water was not being used while scrubber blower was on during inspection
EUBLINE	PTI 294-00D, Special Condition 3.2	Scrubber flow rate monitor not operating during inspection
EUBLINE	PTI 294-00D, Special Condition 3.3	Scrubber flow rate records were not provided

On February 15, 2017, the AQD staff observed operation of EUBLINE while the packed bed scrubber was malfunctioning/off line/inoperable.

This constitutes a violation of Act 451, Rule 910, which requires that an air-cleaning device shall be installed, maintained, and operated in a satisfactory manner and in accordance with the administrative rules and existing law.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by May 29, 2017 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the

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violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a recurrence.

If PPI Aerospace believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.

Thank you for your attention to resolving the violations cited above and for the cooperation that was extended to me during my inspection of PPI Aerospace.
