SUBJECT: Verification of dismantlement equipment associated with Permit 173-03. sgl		
RESOLVED COMPLAINTS:		

October 1, 2018, AQD District Staff traveled down Farrier Road, from M-32 to verify dismantlement of equipment associated with Permit No. 173-03. Electronic correspondence with Savoy Energy LP Staff indicated that the facility had been dismantled and associated wells plugged in 2015. Instructions regarding how to void a permit were provided upon request to the permittee.

Google Earth Aerials dated 2016 appeared to show the location of only one potential oil and gas station operating in Section 34, T 30N, R4E. The referenced location was approximately 1 -1.25 mile south of Farrier and Landing Roads on the west side of the road and consisted of up to three buildings. Previous aerials dated 2006 and 2010 showed 3 ASTs and what was believed to be a dehy unit. The referenced equipment is not visible in the 2016 aerial. In addition, all access gates along Farrier Road, were not only locked and unmarked, but also showed NO traffic patterns, when even intermittent traffic back to wells or the CPF would have shown paths across planted fields and pasture from the gates farther into the property.

District Oil, Gas & Mineral Staff has been contacted to verify the reported abandonment of the Savoy Energy Wells, which would further verify the dismantlement of equipment associated with the site. Information provided confirmed well abandonment and removal of equipment associated with CPF. See documentation in file. sgl.
