VIOLATION NOTICE

On May 4, May 24, and June 27, 2017, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted inspections of Pyramid Paving & Contracting located at Fairview Road, West Branch, Ogemaw County, Michigan. The purpose of these inspections was to determine if the referenced facility was operating in compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the Air Pollution Control Rules; and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 149-03D;

During the referenced inspection dates, and in subsequent record reviews, staff observed the following:

Process Description	Rule/Permit Condition Violated	Comments
EUHMAPLANT	SC III.5	Boiler tune-up not conducted prior to seasonal start up.
EUHMAPLANT	SC VI.3	CO emission monitoring with hand held monitor did not meet data set criteria.

This process is also subject to the federal Standards of Performance for New Sources (NSPS) for Hot Mix Asphalt Plants. These standards are found in Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 60, Subpart I.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the above cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by August 2, 2017 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the referenced violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the referenced violations; whether the referenced violations are still ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the

violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If Pyramid Paving & Contracting believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.

Thank you for your attention to resolving the violations cited above and for the cooperation that was extended to me during my inspections and subsequent records requests by your staff.
