VIOLATION NOTICE

On May 29, 2014, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Johnson-Matthey Vehicle Testing & Development located at 25201 Brest Road, Taylor, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 31-07B.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Engine Testing	PTI # 31-07B (Conditions SC, 1.1-13)	Failure to produce emission records

During this inspection, Johnson-Matthey Vehicle Testing & Development was unable to produce emission records.

This is a violation of the recordkeeping and emission limitations specified in Special Condition number SC. 1.1-1.13 of Gen Permit # 31-07B.

The conditions of PTI numbers 31-07B require maintenance of records, which shall be made available for review upon request by the AQD staff.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by July 21, 2014, which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter. The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
