VIOLATION NOTICE

On August 18, 2014, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Grand Canyon CPF located at NW SE SW Section 32, Vanderbilt, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Grand Canyon CPF's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 130-11.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

SVENGINE1	VIII. Stack/Vent Restrictions - Exhaust gases from the stack must be discharged unobstructed vertically upwards to the ambient air	The stack has a curved section at the top of the exhaust pipe which does not allow unobstructed vertically upwards exhaust

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by September 8, 2014 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If Arbor Operating LLC believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.

Thank you for your attention to resolving the violation cited above and for the cooperation that was extended to me during my inspection of Grand Canyon CPF.
