VIOLATION NOTICE

On December 12, 2013, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), received a relocation notice for Revolution Onsite Crushing (Facility) scheduled to be located at L & L Aggregate, Ingham County, Michigan, on December 6, 2013. This relocation notice was late. The Permit to Install (PTI) No. 192-12, Condition 1.13.c, requires that relocation notices be provided at least 10 days prior to the scheduled relocation.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by January 8, 2014. The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence. Also, please confirm whether or not this is the first use of the equipment.

If the Facility believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
