VIOLATION NOTICE

On May 18, 2017, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD) conducted an inspection of Fowler's Farm-City Sales (Fowler's) anhydrous ammonia tank located at the intersection of West Washington and South Alger Roads, Ithaca. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Fowler's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the Air Pollution Control Rules; and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 357-77.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

During the inspection, it was noted there was no emergency contact sign located at the anhydrous ammonia tank site. The absence of the sign has resulted in non-compliance with special condition 7 of PTI No. 357-77. Special Condition 7 requires a sign be present containing emergency contact phone numbers for the owner, primary operator, local and state police, local fire department, and ambulance service.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by June 29, 2017. The written response should include: the dates or duration of the violation; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If Fowler's believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.

Thank you for your attention to resolving the violation cited above and for the cooperation that was extended to me during our phone call on June 1, 2017.
