Torch cutting of metal has always been done at a minimum, once a week at best for short periods of time after Dec. 20, 2016. Only on over sized steel that is too big to ship back to our Toledo facility. We were unaware of Rule 201-No Permit to Install (PTI) that went into effect Dec. 20, 2016. We are currently working on getting a sheer crane for this facility to remedy this violation by the end of the year.

Our state license to buy scrap cars was effective 09/08/16. Auto bodies are purchased on a daily basis. I have already enrolled ELVS and will receive a mercury buck within 10 business day from August, 15, 2017. All fuel tanks are removed/emptied before entering the facility. We will be having a rack built for fluid removal (oil, coolant and Transmission fluid) and separate drums to hold each fluid type for proper disposal. We are hoping to have all fluid removal in place by 10/31/17.

Burning cardboard boxes started mid July. We were told by the local fire department that it was ok to burn the way we had it set up. Until DEQ showed up we thought it was ok. We stopped all burning August 10, 2017. All employees have been made aware that all burning is prohibited.
