VIOLATION NOTICE

On October 15, 2024, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Bell Site Development located at 5100 Hudson Road, Waterford, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Bell Site Development's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the Air Pollution Control Rules; and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 59-23.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

EU-PROCESS	PTI 59-23, Section V.1 NSPS, 40 CFR 60, Subparts A and OOO	Bell Site Development has not conducted a visible emissions performance test within 180 days of commencement of trial operation.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by November 6, 2024 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
