I am returning a letter in response to your
to yours Dated March 6th 2019.

that I cut up and put in my stone. As you noted
I was in violation on the 27th of February when you came
to my shop, but have stopped making pieces with
my chainsaw and am no longer putting them in my
stone.

There was no black smoke coming out of my stone or

I have a Presser Blower on my stone and force air
into the fire box which makes my fire burn clean and
very hot. I believe the person that called, Mr. Chamberlyn,
painted a bad picture of what I was doing so you would
come out and see for yourself. When you were here on the
7th of February you saw no Black smoke as you stated
~ Page one Par 2 you came at random, I was doing
that I always was doing and my stone was burning
clean. You saw it. I burnt pieces of tires to keep my

"big" wood going that I would get from the city or from tree services, I used them like kindler. The tie pieces would generate the "big wood" and help keep them burning. but please note I told you it would stop.

The man that complained, comes over to my shop quit often and has something negative to wine about...

my mobilehome lowers his house value, he throws beer bottles over his fence at my shop. For him to gather the info: he had to trespass on my land cause I saw his foot prints in the snow around my wood pile & I went and asked him what he was doing on my land and he said he was rabbit hunting which was a lie. He was getting pictures.

He will no doubt be calling you again because he hates my shop so near his home. I was here first 50+ years, he only 20, he build to close to my shop my chimney was there when he build his home he never thought that smoke comes out of chimines.

My only question would be is there ever a way that a small amount of ties could be burned. it appers not to me.
