**VIOLATION NOTICE**

On November 6, 2019 the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Bay Area Demolition's temporary work site located at 126 East 8th Street, Traverse City, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Bay Area Demolition, LLC compliance with the requirements of the Federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); Air Pollution Control Rules; and to investigate the compliance with asbestos regulations and operation of unpermitted shredder equipment that occurred on November 1, 2019, as documented by a local news media source.

During the inspection, staff confirmed the following:

Mobile House Shredder	R 336.1201 of Air Pollution Control Rules	Owner confirmed - November 1, 2019 usage.

During this inspection, it was noted that Bay Area Demolition, LLC had commenced operation of unpermitted equipment at this facility. The AQD staff advised Bay Area Demolition, LLC on November 6, 2019, that this is a violation of Rule 201 of the administrative rules promulgated under Act 451.

Be advised that Rule 201 requires that a permit be obtained PRIOR to installation, construction, operation, reconstruction, relocation, or alteration of any process or process equipment which may be a source of an air contaminant.

Based on the inspection and documentation from a local news source, AQD is requesting that Bay Area Demolition, LLC submit a PTI Application by December 23, 2019 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). Please submit your PTI application to the Permits Section, as well as a copy to my attention at EGLE- AQD, Cadillac District, at 120 West Chapin Street, Cadillac, Michigan 49601; and submit a copy to Ms. Jenine Camilleri, Enforcement Unit Supervisor at EGLE, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7760.

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If Bay Area Demolition, LLC believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.

Thank you for your attention to resolving the violation cited above and for the cooperation that was extended to AQD during the inspection of Bay Area Demolition, LLC.
