

ENFORCEMENT NOTICE

ATTENTION: Mr. Mike Hollerbach and Mr. Craig Siemans:

This letter is to advise you of the commencement of escalated enforcement action against Hollerbach Excavating, Inc. and Siemans Ford, Inc (Companies) for alleged violations that occurred at 8981 Red Arrow Highway, Bridgman, Michigan (ID: U111900321). This letter follows the January 14, 2019, Violation Notice issued by the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD) which details violations of the National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for asbestos (Asbestos NESHAP), Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 61, Subpart M; and Rule 942 of the Michigan Air Pollution Control Rules, Mich Admin Code, R 336.1942. A second Violation Notice was sent to Hollerbach Excavating on February 6, 2019 for failing to respond to the January 14, 2019, Violation Notice. A response from Hollerbach Excavating was received on February 19, 2019. These regulations hold all owners and operators, such as contractors and/or subcontractors, fully liable for compliance with the Asbestos NESHAP.

The AQD is providing the Companies with an opportunity to formally resolve these violations through the entry of a legally enforceable agreement that will include a compliance program and payment of an appropriate monetary penalty pursuant to Section 5528 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, MCL 324.5528.

Be advised that failure to respond to this Enforcement Notice in a timely manner and adequately resolve or address the cited violations may result in further enforcement proceedings, including but not limited to, referral of the matter to the Michigan Department of Attorney General (DAG) for commencement of civil litigation. This Enforcement Notice does not preclude or limit the DEQ's ability to initiate any other enforcement action under federal or state law as appropriate.
