VIOLATION NOTICE

On July 8, 2021, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Paradise Recreational Sports located at 8165 M-123, Paradise, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Paradise Recreational Sports compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the Air Pollution Control Rules; and to investigate a recent complaint which we received on June 11, 2021, regarding burning of waste attributed to Paradise Recreational Sports operations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Process Description	Rule/Permit Condition Violated	Comments
Incinerator	Rule 336.1201	Installation and operation of an incinerator without obtaining a PTI.

During this inspection, it was noted that Paradise Recreational Sports had installed and commenced operation off unpermitted equipment at this facility. The AQD staff advised Paradise Recreational Sports on July 8, 2021, that this is a violation of Rule 201 of the administrative rules promulgated under Act 451. The burning of commercial and industrial waste is prohibited unless a company has obtained a permit from the AQD.

A program for compliance may include a completed PTI application for the incinerator process equipment. An application form is available by request, or at the following website: www.michigan.gov/air (in the shaded box on the upper right-hand side of the page).

Be advised that Rule 201 requires that a permit be obtained prior to installation, construction, operation, reconstruction, relocation, or alteration of any process or process equipment which may be a source of an air contaminant.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by August 5, 2021 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

Please submit the written response to EGLE, AQD, Marquette District, at 1504 West Washington Street, Marquette, Michigan 49855 and submit a copy to Ms. Jenine Camilleri, Enforcement Unit Supervisor at EGLE, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7760.

If Paradise Recreational Sports believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
