VIOLATION NOTICE

On March 20, 2019, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division, conducted an inspection of the vacant residence located at 2300 Alexander Street, Flint, Michigan 48505. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 61, National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), Subpart M and Rule 942 of the administrative rules promulgated under Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to our investigation, the Genesee County Land Bank owns the facility and BDS Environmental performed the abatement activities at the facility. The NESHAP for Asbestos holds both the owner and operator equally liable for violations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following: A BDS Environmental crew was removing regulated asbestos-containing material (RACM) linoleum flooring from within the subject vacant residence on March 20, 2019. The last notification submitted for planned renovation work specified asbestos removal would occur on March 9, 2019 from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a signed written response to this Violation Notice by April 15, 2019 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The response should include: the dates the

violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If BDS Environmental believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide factual information to explain your position.
