VIOLATION NOTICE

On February 26, 2014, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Rayner Farms located at 8164 Deckerville, Fairgrove, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Rayner Farms' compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules and Rule 201.

During this inspection, it was noted that Rayner Farms had installed and/or commenced operation of an unpermitted process/equipment at this facility. This is a violation of Act 451, Rule 201.

A program for compliance may include a completed Process to Install application for the incinerator process equipment. An application form is available by request, or at the following website:

Be advised that Rule 201 requires that a permit be obtained prior to installation, construction, operation, reconstruction, relocation, or alteration of any process or process equipment which may be a source of an air contaminant. Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by March 20, 2014 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter).

If Rayner Farms believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.

Thank you for your attention to resolving the violation cited above and for the cooperation that was extended to me during my inspection of Rayner Farms. If you
