## **VIOLATION NOTICE**

On September 12, 2019, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), performed an asbestos NESHAP (National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants) inspection at 2255 Pinckney Road, Howell, Livingston County. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451).

According to my investigation, Capital Construction Group owns the subject property and has performed the demolition activities as well. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos holds both the *owner and operator* equally liable for any violations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

The subject facility was in the process of being demolished. The submitted Notification of Intent to Renovate/Demolish (document #0000169587) has the project schedule with a start date of 8-20-18 and an end date of 9-30-2018. The owner/operator failed to update the notification to reflect the new project schedule.

On 9-12-19, staff performed an inspection of a demolition at 2255 Pinckney Road, Howell. Owner/operator's notification had expired, and the facility was being demolished outside of the notification's project schedule.	40 CFR 61.145 (b)(2)	Failure to update notice.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this violation notice by October 9, 2019, which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter. The written response should include: dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken or are proposed to be taken to correct the

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violation, and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If you believe the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute a violation of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
