**VIOLATION NOTICE**

On June 2, 2021, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD) conducted an inspection at 2830 Clark Road, Hartland, Livingston County. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to my investigation, Mr. Lindahl is the owner of the facility and the Hartland Deerfield Fire Authority is the entity performing the Intentional Burn activities. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos (NESHAP) holds the *owner and operator* liable for all violations.

During the inspection, EGLE staff observed the following:

The building was in the process of fire training exercises. Thermal Systems Insulation (TSI) was noted on three ducts located in the basement. The ducts were connected to the first-floor registers. The asbestos survey report did not identify the TSI. Both the owner and the operator failed to have a thorough survey done on the property prior to the Intentional Burn activities.

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

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this violation notice by June 24, 2021, (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the date(s) the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation, and the date(s) by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence. If you believe the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute a violation of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
