On Thursday, October 11, 2018, Michigan Department of Environmental Quality-Air Quality Division (MDEQ-AQD) staff, I, Adam Bognar, conducted an unannounced self initiated inspection of Donato Enterprises located at 81600 Belle River Road, Memphis, MI 48167. The purpose of this inspection was to determine the facility's compliance status with the Federal Clean Air Act; Article II, Part 55, Air Pollution Control of Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 Public Act 451; and Michigan Department of Environmental Quality, Air Quality Division (MDEQ-AQD) rules.

I arrived at this facility at 3:45 pm. I met with Mr. Christopher Donato, President. I identified myself, provided credentials, and stated the purpose of the inspection. Mr. Donato was in a hurry and assured me that no manufacturing takes place at this facility. I informed him that his website stated that they use glue on parts and that adhesive application processes are regulated by MDEQ-AQD rules.

Mr. Donato agreed to give me a tour of the facility. Donato Enterprises is in the business of parts inspection. The facility receives parts from various sources, spreads them out between work stations, and inspects each individual part for quality assurance.

Occasionally, a part will have an unwanted metal burr on it that needs to be ground off. Grinding is only performed indoors using a small hand tool. There is no exhaust system for the grinding.

He explained that they no longer apply any adhesive to parts, but when they did, it was only a tiny amount out of a household size super-glue bottle.

**Compliance Determination**

This facility appears to be in compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); and Michigan Department of Environmental Quality-Air Quality Division (MDEQ-AQD) Administrative Rules.
