## **VIOLATION NOTICE**

On March 20, 2017, the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Air Quality Division, performed an asbestos NESHAP (National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants) inspection at 307 West Indian Street, Midland, Midland County. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451).

According to my investigation, TCP Investments owns the subject facility and Pat's Gradall Service, Inc., performed the demolition. The demolition activities took place on or about March 20, 2017. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos holds both the owner and operator equally liable for any violations.

During the inspection, staff noted the following: the residential structure had been demolished and both TCP Investments and Pat's Gradall Service, Inc., failed to submit a 10-working day notification of Intent to Renovate/Demolish to the administrator prior to the demolition activities. Additionally, TCP Investments and Pat's Gardall Service, Inc., failed to submit a 10-working day notification of Intent to Renovate/Demolish prior to demolition activities that took place at 411 and 415 Fitzhugh Street, Midland, Midland County, as well.

Attempted to perform a post abatement inspection on the subject facilities. However, upon arrival the homes were demolished. No 10-working day notification was submitted to the administrator for the demolition activities at 307 West Indian, 411 Fitzhugh and 415 Fitzhugh, Midland, Midland County.	40 CFR 61.145 (b)(1)(3)(i)	Failure to provide the administrator with written notice, 10-working days prior to demolition.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this violation notice by April 19, 2017, (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation, and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence. If you believe the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute a violation of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
