VIOLATION NOTICE

On October 2, 2017, the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Air Quality Division, performed an asbestos NESHAP (National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants) inspection at 8721 Ferry Street, Montague, Muskegon County. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451).

According to my inspection, the City of Montague is the owner representative for the subject facility and Press's LLC, performed the demolition activities. The asbestos NESHAP holds both the owner and the operator equally liable for any violations.

During the inspection, I observed the following:

The commercial building was in the process of being demolished without waiting the required 10 working days before any demolition could begin. Both liable parties had failed to adhere to the project schedule and started demolishing the building prior to the submitted notification's start date of October 9, 2017.

The written response should include: the date(s) the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation, and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
