### SECOND VIOLATION NOTICE

On September 19, 20 and 24th, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division, conducted an inspection of the former Salvation Army located at 108 and 118 W. Lawrence, Pontiac. The purpose of this inspection was to determine M1 Bunker, LLC's and R.T.R. Services, Corp.'s compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 61, National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), Subpart M and Rule 942 of the administrative rules promulgated under Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

On October 2, 2018, the AQD sent M1 Bunker, LLC a Violation Notice citing violations discovered as a result of the inspection and requested your written response by October 23, 2018. A copy of that letter is enclosed for your reference. As of this date, we have not received your response.

Please be advised that failure to respond in writing and identifying actions M1 Bunker, LLC will take or has taken to resolve the cited violations may result in escalated enforcement action by the AQD. Please provide the information requested in our October 2, 2018 letter by November 15, 2018, which corresponds to 14 days from the date of this letter.

Be further advised that issuance of this Violation Notice does not preclude or limit the DEQ's ability to initiate any other enforcement action under state or federal law as appropriate.
