VIOLATION NOTICE

On February 26, 2021, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of the two (2) vacant residential properties located at 21405 Napier and 51860 8 Mile Road, Lyon Township. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 61, National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), Subpart M and Rule 942 of the administrative rules promulgated under Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to our investigation, Devonshire of Lyon LLC owns the facility and Trowbridge Land Holdings LLC was responsible for the demolition activities at the properties. The NESHAP for Asbestos holds both the owner and operator equally liable for violations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following: Records indicate that two (2) single family residences were demolished as part of this project to build a multi-unit subdivision. A 10-day notification of intent was not submitted prior to demolition of the structures. The owner/operator of the properties was made aware of the NESHAP 10-day notification requirements by EGLE staff in an email dated July 24, 2020.

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Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a signed written response to this Violation Notice by April 9, 2021 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence. If there was a third party that conducted the actual demolitions, please provide the appropriate contact information.
