SECOND VIOLATION NOTICE

On July 31, 2013, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Entech, Inc. (Facility), located at 69676 M-103, White Pigeon, Michigan.

The purpose of the inspection was to determine the Facility's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; and Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules; and to investigate a recent complaint that the DEQ, AQD, received on July 24, 2013, regarding burned rubber odors attributed to operations at the Facility.

On August 6, 2013, the AQD sent the Facility a Violation Notice citing a violation discovered as a result of the inspection and requested your written response by August 27, 2013. A copy of that letter is enclosed for your reference. On August 29, 2013, the Facility submitted a permit application for the equipment. However, after this date, the Facility intended to install control equipment under a Permit to Install exemption. As of this date, the DEQ, AQD, has not received your response regarding this equipment.

Please be advised that failure to respond in writing and identifying actions the Facility will take or has taken to resolve the cited violation may result in escalated enforcement action by the AQD. Please provide the information requested in our August 6, 2013, letter by July 7, 2014, which corresponds to 14 days from the date of this letter.

Be further advised that issuance of this Violation Notice does not preclude or limit the DEQ's ability to initiate any other enforcement action under state or federal law as appropriate.
