VIOLATION NOTICE

On September 16, 2019 and October 10, 2019, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), performed an asbestos NESHAP (National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants) inspection at 116 West Jefferson Street, Ann Arbor, Washtenaw County. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451).

According to my investigation, West Jefferson Street, LLC, owns the subject property and Excavators, Inc., performed the demolition activities. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos holds both the *owner and operator* equally liable for any violations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

The subject facility had a demolition permit from the City of Ann Arbor. However, during my inspection of the property located at 116 West Jefferson Street on September 16, 2019, I observed properties with structures still standing at 441 South Ashley Street and 116 West Jefferson Street. During my inspection on October 10, 2019, I observed that the structure at 116 West Jefferson Street was demolished with only a basement foundation remaining. I noted from satellite imagery that the structures at 112 West Jefferson Street and 118 West Jefferson Street were formerly standing but are now demolished and gone. A statement from the operator of Excavators, Inc., was made that they had demolished all the above mentioned structures and were preparing to demolish 441 South Ashley Street next.

The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation, and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
