SECOND VIOLATION NOTICE

On September 16, 2019; September 19, 2019; September 25, 2019; and October 14, 2019, the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD) performed an asbestos inspection at 6100 McGraw Street, Detroit, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

On October 23, 2019, the AQD sent a Violation Notice (VN) citing violations discovered because of the inspection and requested a written response by November 13, 2019. A copy of this VN has been enclosed for your reference. As of the date of this letter, the AQD has not received the written response to the cited violations.

Please be advised that failure to respond in writing and identifying actions taken to resolve the cited violations may result in an escalated enforcement action by the AQD. Please provide the information requested in the VN dated October 23, 2019, by December 5, 2019, which corresponds to 14 days from the date of this letter.


