## **VIOLATION NOTICE**

On November 7, 2019, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), performed an asbestos NESHAP (National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants) inspection at 15025 Dix Toledo Road, Southgate, Wayne County. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451).

According to my investigation, Ms. Tien Park owns the subject property and Technical Environmental Services, Inc. performed the demolition activities. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos holds both the *owner and operator* equally liable for any violations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

The subject facility previously had a notification in for the abatement of window glazing prior to demolition. However, the subject facility did not have a notification in for demolition which was actively occurring during the inspection.

On 11/7/19, staff performed an inspection at 15025 Dix Toledo Road, Southgate. During the inspection, staff observed demolition activities. Upon further investigation, no scheduled demolition notice was in place.	40 CFR 61.145 (b)(1)	Failure to provide 10 working day notification.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this violation notice by December 3, 2019, (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the date(s) the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation, and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
