This letter is in reference to your Permit to Install (PTI) Application No. 14-19A, for modifications to the automotive assembly line currently under construction at 4000 Saint Jean Street, Michigan (State Registration Number N2155).

A virtual public hearing was held on September 9, 2020, and the public comment period ended on September 18, 2020. Comments were received during the public comment period and at the virtual public hearing.

After careful consideration of the issues and pursuant to the delegation of authority from the Director of the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), I have approved PTI No. 14-19A. As a part of this approval, the Air Quality Division (AQD) staff has revised and added conditions to the permit to address certain information received during the public participation process and the subsequent analysis of that information.

The AQD has prepared the enclosed Response to Comments Document (RTC), which provides our responses to comments received during the public comment period and at the public hearing. It also identifies the special conditions that have been modified and provides our rationale for modifying the proposed special conditions. These changes are listed in Section II of the RTC.

This approval is based upon and subject to compliance with all administrative rules of EGLE and conditions stipulated in the enclosed supplement. Please review these conditions thoroughly so that you may take the actions necessary to ensure compliance with all of these conditions.

The equipment covered by this permit is also subject to the requirements of the Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) Program. Submittal of the M-001 and C-001 forms may be required prior to commencing operation. A change that is subject to Rule 215 subrules (1), (2), or (3), promulgated pursuant to Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, requires the submittal of the forms to the appropriate AQD District Office. If a change is made pursuant to Rule 216, please submit the required forms to the Cadillac District

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Office at the address provided in the M-001 form instructions. Also, you must notify the Detroit District Office, in writing, within 30 days after completion of the installation, construction, reconstruction, relocation, or modification of the process or process equipment covered by this PTI.

Additional information is included in the M-001 form instructions which are available on the Internet or can be obtained by contacting the Detroit District Office at 313-456-4700. The AQD permit Web page is located at https://www.michigan.gov/air, click the "Permits" tab, and click the link at the first bullet entitled "Air Quality Division Permits."

Also, PTI No. 14-19 will be voided because the equipment is now covered by PTI No. 14-19A.
