This letter is in reference to your Permit to Install (PTI) application, identified as No. APP-2022-0004, for optimizing sulfur production at the two sulfur recovery units located at Marathon Petroleum Company LP's Detroit Refinery, 1001 South Oakwood Boulevard in Detroit, Michigan (State Registration Number A9831).

The public comment period ended on August 10, 2022, and a public hearing was held August 1, 2022. Comments were received during the comment period. After careful consideration of the issues and pursuant to the delegation of authority from the Director of the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), I have approved PTI No. 113-22.

The Air Quality Division (AQD) has prepared the enclosed Response to Comments (RTC) Document, which provides our responses to comments received during the public comment period and at the public hearing. The RTC Document and the Permit Terms and Conditions are available at: Michigan.gov/EGLEAirPublicNotice, choose "Final Decisions." Translation of these documents is available upon request.

This approval is based upon and subject to compliance with all administrative rules of EGLE and conditions stipulated in the enclosed supplement. Please review these conditions thoroughly so that you may take the actions necessary to ensure compliance with all of these conditions.

The equipment covered by this permit is also subject to the requirements of the Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) Program. Submittal of the M-001 and C-001 forms may be required prior to commencing operation. A change that is subject to Rule 215 subrules (1), (2), or (3), promulgated pursuant to Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, requires the submittal of the forms to the appropriate AQD District Office. If a change is made pursuant to Rule 216, please submit the required forms to the Grand Rapids District Office at the address provided in the M-001 form instructions. Also, you must notify the Detroit District Office, in writing, within 30 days after completion of the installation, construction, reconstruction, relocation, or modification of the process or process equipment covered by this PTI.
