Thank you for your interest regarding the Permit to Install (PTI) Application No. APP-2022-0004 submitted by Marathon Petroleum Company LP, to the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), for optimizing sulfur production at the two sulfur recovery units located at Marathon Petroleum Company LP's Detroit Refinery, 1001 South Oakwood Boulevard in Detroit, Michigan.

Pursuant to state and federal requirements, EGLE held a public comment period that ended on August 10, 2022, and a public hearing on August 1, 2022, on its proposed conditional approval of the permit. The Air Quality Division (AQD) received four sets of comments during the public comment period.

After careful consideration of the issues and pursuant to the delegation of authority from the Director of EGLE, I have approved PTI No. 113-22.
