This letter is in reference to your Permit to Install (PTI) application, identified as No. APP-2022-0124, for an increase in allowed throughput for the existing powder manufacturing process and replacement of certain control devices located at 19300 Filer Avenue in Detroit, Michigan (State Registration Number A8892).

The public comment period ended on August 7, 2023, and a virtual public hearing was held on July 27, 2023. Comments were received during the comment period and at the virtual public hearing. After careful consideration of the issues and pursuant to the delegation of authority from the Director of the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), I have approved PTI No. 549-97D with no changes.

The Air Quality Division (AQD) has prepared the enclosed Response to Comments (RTC) Document, which provides our responses to comments received during the public comment period and at the virtual public hearing.
