Dear Interested Party:

We are sending you this information because you may have an interest in air quality related activities associated with AmeriTi Manufacturing LLC. The company has submitted an air permit application (No. APP-2022-0124) for an increase in allowed throughput for their existing powder manufacturing process and replacement of certain control devices. The facility is located at 19300 Filer Avenue in Detroit, Michigan.

The law requires the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) to open some actions for the public to comment on, such as what AmeriTi Manufacturing LLC is requesting. Public comments are a very important part of making sure the application has been thoroughly reviewed.

Information about the air permit application, such as the summary of the proposed project, the proposed permit conditions, and the fact sheet containing the regulatory analysis of the proposed permit conditions are available to review.
