This letter is in reference to your Permit to Install (PTI) application, identified as No. APP-2023-0070, for a new blast furnace slag grinding plant located at 8941 West Jefferson in Detroit, Michigan (State Registration Number B4249).

The public comment period ended on October 31, 2023, and a public hearing was held on October 18, 2023. Comments were received during the comment period and at the public hearing. After careful consideration of the issues and pursuant to the delegation of authority from the Director of the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), I have approved PTI No. 135-23.

The Air Quality Division (AQD) has prepared the enclosed Response to Comments (RTC) Document, which provides our responses to comments received during the public comment period and at the public hearing. It also identifies the special conditions that have been modified and provides our rationale for modifying the proposed special conditions. These changes are listed in Section II of the RTC Document. The RTC Document and the Permit Terms and Conditions are available at Michigan.gov/EGLEAirPublicNotice, choose "Final Decisions."

This approval is based upon and subject to compliance with all administrative rules of EGLE and conditions stipulated in the enclosed supplement. Please review these conditions thoroughly so that you may take the actions necessary to ensure compliance with all of these conditions.
