Dear Interested Party:

We are sending you this information because you may have an interest in air quality related activities associated with Universal Coating, Inc. at 5204 Energy Drive in Flint, Michigan. The company has submitted an air permit application (No. APP-2023-0147) for the proposed installation and operation of two new tumble spray coating lines. No emission increases were requested above the existing permitted emission limits in this application.

The law requires the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) to provide the public an opportunity to comment on the proposed air permit. Public comments are a very important part of making sure the application has been thoroughly reviewed and the proposed air permit contains the necessary requirements to meet all the rules.

Information about the air permit application, such as a summary of the proposed project, the proposed permit conditions, and the fact sheet containing the regulatory analysis of the project are available to review.
