This letter is in reference to your Permit to Install (PTI) application, identified as No. APP-2023-0168, for changing the stack parameters at your existing facility (State Registration Number B1772) located at 151 Lafayette Street in Mt. Clemens, Michigan.

The public comment period ended on October 20, 2023. A virtual public hearing did not take place as one was not requested. The Air Quality Division (AQD) did not receive any comments during the public comment period. After careful consideration of the issues and pursuant to the delegation of authority from the Director of the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), I have approved PTI No. 94-21B.

This approval is based upon and subject to compliance with all administrative rules of EGLE and conditions stipulated in the enclosed supplement. Please review these conditions thoroughly so that you may take the actions necessary to ensure compliance with all of these conditions.

The equipment covered by this permit is also subject to the requirements of the Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) Program. Submittal of the M-001 and C-001 forms may be required prior to commencing operation. A change that is subject to Rule 215 subrules (1), (2), or (3), promulgated pursuant to Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, requires the submittal of the forms to the appropriate AQD District Office. If a change is made pursuant to Rule 216, please submit the required forms to the Grand Rapids District Office at the address provided in the M-001 form instructions. Also, you must notify the Warren District Office, in writing, within 30 days after completion of the installation, construction, reconstruction, relocation, or modification of the process or process equipment covered by this PTI.

Additional information is included in the M-001 form instructions which are available on the Internet or can be obtained by contacting the Warren District Office at 586-753-3700. The AQD ROP Web page is located at <u>Renewable Operating Permits (ROPs) /</u><u>Title V</u>."

Also, PTI No. 94-21A will be voided because the equipment is now covered by PTI No. 94-21B.
