Thank you for your interest regarding the Permit to Install (PTI) Application No. APP-2023-0168 submitted by Cecil Composites, LLC, to the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), requesting to change the stack parameters at their existing facility located at 151 Lafayette Street in Mt. Clemens, Michigan.

Pursuant to state and federal requirements, EGLE held a public comment period that ended on October 20, 2023. A virtual public hearing did not take place as one was not requested. The Air Quality Division (AQD) did not receive any comments during the public comment period.
