Dear Interested Party:

We are sending you this information because you may have an interest in air quality related activities associated with Industrial Metal Coating located at 6070 Eighteen Mile Road in Sterling Heights, Michigan. The company has submitted an air permit application (No. APP-2023-0259) for the proposed modification of two existing burn-off ovens to install and operate additional pollution controls, called secondary chamber afterburners.

The law requires the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) to provide the public an opportunity to comment on the proposed air permit. Public comments are a very important part of making sure the application has been thoroughly reviewed and the proposed air permit contains the necessary requirements to meet all of the rules.

Information about the air permit application, such as the summary of the proposed project, the proposed permit conditions, and a fact sheet containing the regulatory analysis of the proposed permit conditions are available to review.
