Types of Documents

Document	Description
Response to Comments Document	Provides responses to comments that were submitted during the public comment period and/or at the hearing and provides information about the public hearing and changes made to the permit. **Note: if no comments were received during the comment period, this document is not necessary.
Proposed Project Summary	Provides a brief overview of the proposed project.
Final Permit Terms and Conditions	Includes the permit requirements based on a thorough review of the application. These are the final permit requirements that the facility must follow to ensure the process operates in compliance with applicable air quality rules and regulations. These conditions may have been updated or changed based on comments received during the comment period.
Interested Party Letter	Informs those who have indicated their interest in the facility of the permit decision. It also identifies the dates of the public comment period, the date of the public hearing and how many comments were received, if any. This letter also informs the interested party if there were any changes to the permit conditions based on comments received.
Company Letter	Informs company of the permit decision. This letter also identifies the dates of the public comment period, whether a hearing was held and if comments were received. It also indicates if any changes were made to the proposed permit terms and conditions.
