This letter is in reference to your Permit to Install (PTI) application, No. APP-2022-0290, State Registration Number A7809. The application was received on November 9, 2022, for incorporating requirements from the Sulfur Dioxide Federal Implementation Plan into a PTI for existing Boilerhouse No. 2 located at 1300 Zug Island Road in River Rouge, Michigan.

The public comment period ended on August 28, 2023. No comments were received nor was a request for a public hearing made during this period. Pursuant to the delegation of authority from the Director of the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), I have approved PTI No. 108-23.

The equipment covered by this permit is also subject to the requirements of the Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) Program. Submittal of the M-001 and C-001 forms may be required prior to commencing operation. A change that is subject to Rule 215 subrules (1), (2), or (3), promulgated pursuant to Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, requires the submittal of the forms to the appropriate AQD District Office. If a change is made pursuant to Rule 216, please submit the required forms to the Grand Rapids District Office at the address provided in the M-001 form instructions. Also, you must notify the Detroit District Office, in writing, within 30 days after completion of the installation, construction, reconstruction, relocation, or modification of the process or process equipment covered by this PTI.
